PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 9

In accordance with the powers vested in the Office of Chairman by the *Tax Appeal Board Act*, Chap.4:50, Section 6(13), to give directions for the hearing of appeals before the Tax Appeal Board, the following directions are hereby issued:

1. All persons filing a document with the Court who are required to sign their name should also print their name below the signature in block letters. Where a replica signature is printed electronically or by other mechanical means on any document, the name of the person whose signature is printed must also be printed so that the person may be identified.
2. All authorities furnished to the Court in support of written or oral submissions, particularly statute and case law should, where possible, be highlighted in yellow with the relevant passages or parts relied upon and these should be submitted in their entirety in hard and soft copy.
3. These directions take effect from 1st January 2021.
